

REGULATION EXHIBITION AREA
WORLD VESPA WEEK
TREVISO - ITALY
May 29-June 2, 2008

Article 1 - ADMISSION TO THE EVENT

Vespa club Treviso index and organizes from 29 May to 2 June 2008 the worldwide gathering wasp World Vespa Week, inside the Family Vespa is an industrial shed where it proposes to spread the culture of restoration media era, road safety and promoting local business. Registration for the event and reserved for holders of Tax Code and / or VAT that will be issued regular bill. In case of statements not satisfying to true if the Exhibitor assume its responsibility if occurring control by the responsible municipal or regional. The acceptance of the application for participation in the exhibition and the allocation of exhibition submitted to unquestionable judgement of the Organization. In the case of non-admission will be notified and will be reimbursed only sums paid no compensation.

Article 2 - HOURS AND ACCESS TO FAIR

The hours of opening to the public are as follows: opening and closing at 9.30 am to 24.00 pm. From Thursday, May 29 to Sunday June 1. Monday, June 2: opening and closing hours 9.30 hours 14.00. The Organization reserves, however, vary opening hours and / or closure of the event, but this may give rise to any claim for reimbursement or indemnity by the exhibitors.

Article 3 - ALLOCATION OF EXHIBITION

The exhibition area of the type required by Exhibitors will be assigned directly by with no background, until exhausted, on the basis of the arrival of requests to participate accompanied by the payment of the exhibition.

Article 4 - TERMS AND TERMS OF PAYMENT

The payment of the total amount to be performed by bank transfer to the following coordinates: BANCO DESIO VENETO FIL. TREVISO, addressed to VESPA CLUB TREVISO, CODE IBAN IT 50J0332712000000000135400. The acceptance of an application for participation is subject to the payment of the exhibition request, until exhaustion of spaces available. The payment will be paid in advance before the event.

Article 5 - MOUNTING

The exhibition areas will be made available to Exhibitors which are equipped with pass, from 14.00 to 18.00 on Wednesday, May 28, 2008 and from 9.30 to 12.00 on Thursday, May 29, 2008. If, within this deadline exhibitors will not have proceeded to occupy the space allotted the organization will reserve the right to consider the same Exhibitor like remissive. In this case the Organisation besides being released to any commitment, he will have the exhibition assigning it to other applicants. Is forbidden to exhibitors to occupy the corridors and exhibition spaces other than those assigned to them. The objects and structures placed outside the space allocated will be removed automatically, at the expense and risk the Exhibitor without further notice or formal notice, the staff assigned to this by the Organization. The exhibitor is obliged, during the period of development, to management and dismantle the space allotted to treat compliance with all the legal standards applicable in the field of prevention, fires, accidents. It is prohibited transfer or share an expo area with other people. It is not allowed the entry of vehicles inside the halls fair. The organization will provide for each exhibition area an electrical panel with an industrial 220 v. from 1.5 kW. Each exhibition area is divided by perimeter walls 2.5 meters high. Is prohibited drilling, painting and change the structures installed. Any additional requests (additional lighting and additional lighting) can be sent by the management, the costs being borne by the exhibitor.

Article 6 - PASS

The Organization issued for a maximum of 4 PASS VISITORS from 14:00 hours to 19:00 hours on Wednesday, May 28, 2008 and Thursday, May 29, 2008 from 10.30 to 18.00 first entry for the development, after verification of Payment in the area marked by special signs. I pass are names and are valid for the duration of the event.

Article 9 - DISMANTLING

At the end of the event and not the first Exhibitors will have to proceed with the removal of all goods exposed. From 14.00 to 18.00 on Monday, June 2, 2008 and from 9.30 to 12.00 Tuesday 3 June 2008.

Article 10 - LIABILITY AND SURVEILLANCE AGAINST THEFT

The Organization is not responding objects or goods left unattended inside the exhibition during the time of mounting, opened to the public and dismantling since the custody and supervision of these areas lies solely with their exhibitors. The exhibition area at night (from 24.00 hours to 7.00 hours) is closed and prohibited access.

Article 11 - GOODS

Is strictly FORBIDDEN expose precious objects, works of art and antiques; are accepted on display inside the halls, in vehicles, means free of fuel. All the goods on display must be owned by the Exhibitor and should not have historical and archaeological value. The exhibitor declares that it has the legal requirements for the use of registered trademarks and / or logos of his property not covered by copyright.

Article 12 - LIABILITY

The Exhibitor exempts the Organization from any liability for any damage caused to others and themselves during the event, its mounting and dismantle.

Article 13 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

The exhibitor is obliged to comply with the requirements that the authorities of Public Security, those responsible for fire prevention, accident prevention and supervision of local open to the public should adopt towards the organization. Although not expressly provided in these Regulations apply the rules of the Civil Code and the Italian legislature. By signing the application for admission applicants declare his knowledge and acceptance, without any reservation, of the General Regulations and also to comply with the effects. C.C. of 1341.
